

Senator Garlan Gudger presents a Check for Berlin Farmer's Market Project

State Sen. Garlan Gudger (R - Cullman) recently presented a \$12,000 check to the town of Berlin to help with construction of a new Farmer's Market, which will provide area family farms with an improved facility to sell produce and give citizens better access to the freshest, locally grown fruits and vegetables.

"Farming is an important industry both in my Senate district and across the entire state," Gudger said.

"Anything we can do to help our family farms grow, prosper, and survive must be done, and I am happy to help make this much needed market a reality."

In addition to the Farmer's Market grant, Sen. Gudger has secured more than \$400,000 for local needs in the Berlin community, including a Rebuild Alabama transportation project and funding to surface County Road 1600, located just off of Highway 278.
